







- Masks no longer required on the shuttles

Key Takeaways from FY22



Work related travel COVID cases significantly impacted TRC/DART Rates



Office ergonomics and student injuries in labs increased



When excluding COVID cases TRC/DART Rates, TRC/DART cases and lost work days reduced



Lost work days cases were primarily associated with slips, trips and falls and material handling injuries



Facilities and Engineering Divisions saw reductions in their injuries




Subcontractors/Contractors had 6 recordable injuries placed on their OSHA 300 Logs

Three Injuries account for 64% of all Injuries:
Struck by/Against
Ergonomics-Computer
Slips, Trips & Falls





Struck By or Against & Slips, Trips and Fall injuries

Struck By/Against injuries occur when a body part is pinched, cut, crushed, touches a sharp object or comes in contact with objects



16 out of 20 incidents involved hands and fingers



Slips, Trips and Fall Injuries







8 out of 11 injuries occurred indoors 2 involved ladder/stepstool use 2 related to walkway obstructions




Key messages: Hold the Rail Pocket Your Phone Walk Mindfully
