### **WD&E Summer Internship Programs**

#### SULI - Science Undergraduate Laboratory Internships

- The DOE SULI program encourages undergraduates, post-baccalaureates and graduate students to pursue STEM careers by providing internships across the 17 DOE National labs
- The summer term for SULI runs 10 weeks from May through August

# Update on Mental Health Initiative

### Progress on Mental Health/Sick Leave Policy at LBNL/UC

This is a follow-up from our discussion on <u>April 20, 2021</u>, pertaining to the sick leave policy and mental health needs.

Thanks to the combined efforts of the Nuclear Science IDEA Council, the Physical Sciences Workplace Life Committee, the Physical Sciences DEI group, and the All Access ERG Mental Health Initiative, the Director of Human Resources for LBNL presented our proposal to UC Systemwide HR to update the Absence from Work policy to be more inclusive of mental health needs.

From UC: "We agree with your suggested revision to PPSM 2.210 (Absence from Work) to call out the parity between mental and physical illness when using sick leave, since we do, in fact, treat mental illness the same as physical illness with respect to requesting sick time under the policy."

#### Nationwide Mental Health Crisis and Suicide Prevention Number

**988** has been designated as the new three-digit dialing code that will route callers to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (now known as the **988** Suicide & Crisis Lifeline), and is now active across the United States.

When people call, text, or chat **988**, they will be connected to trained counselors that are part of the existing Lifeline network. These trained counselors will listen, understand how their problems are affecting them, provide support, and connect them to resources if necessary.
