Instruction for Onsite Access on the first day of Workshop

- Ride the LBNL BLUE Shuttle from Downtown Berkeley. Click <u>HERE</u> to view schedule and map for stops.
- Have the following items ready before you board the shuttle
 - Valid government state ID or passport
 - Copy of your APPROVED LBNL site access. Either printed or electronic from (from your phone). You should have received this email no later than May 16th.
- You are required to show the approved site access and your valid govt. state ID or passport to the driver. You may also be required to show this to the security at the gate or at Bldg 65. The shuttle driver will instruct you.
- If there are more than 5 CPOD participants in the shuttle, the driver will drop you off at Bldg 65, where you need to check-in with Security/Site Operations. Their staff will be out ready to assist you with check-in, so please have your valid government state ID or passport out.
- After you've been checked the security gate or Bldg 65, staff will direct you how to get to Bldg 50 – Auditorium. We will put up signs with arrows, so please follow them.
- When you get to 50-Auditorium, you MUST pick up your Workshop badge at the registration desk. You need your badge to attend all the activities for CPOD. You must carry your badge and your govt. ID at all time while on lab premises.
- Your Workshop Badge with a govt. ID will act as your onsite pass with the shuttle driver and security starting Tuesday, May 21st, until the end of the workshop. <u>When you have your</u> <u>Workshop badge, you can directly be let out at the 50-</u> <u>Auditorium shuttle stop.</u>
