- Well connected with the city center (tram 18 and bus lines)

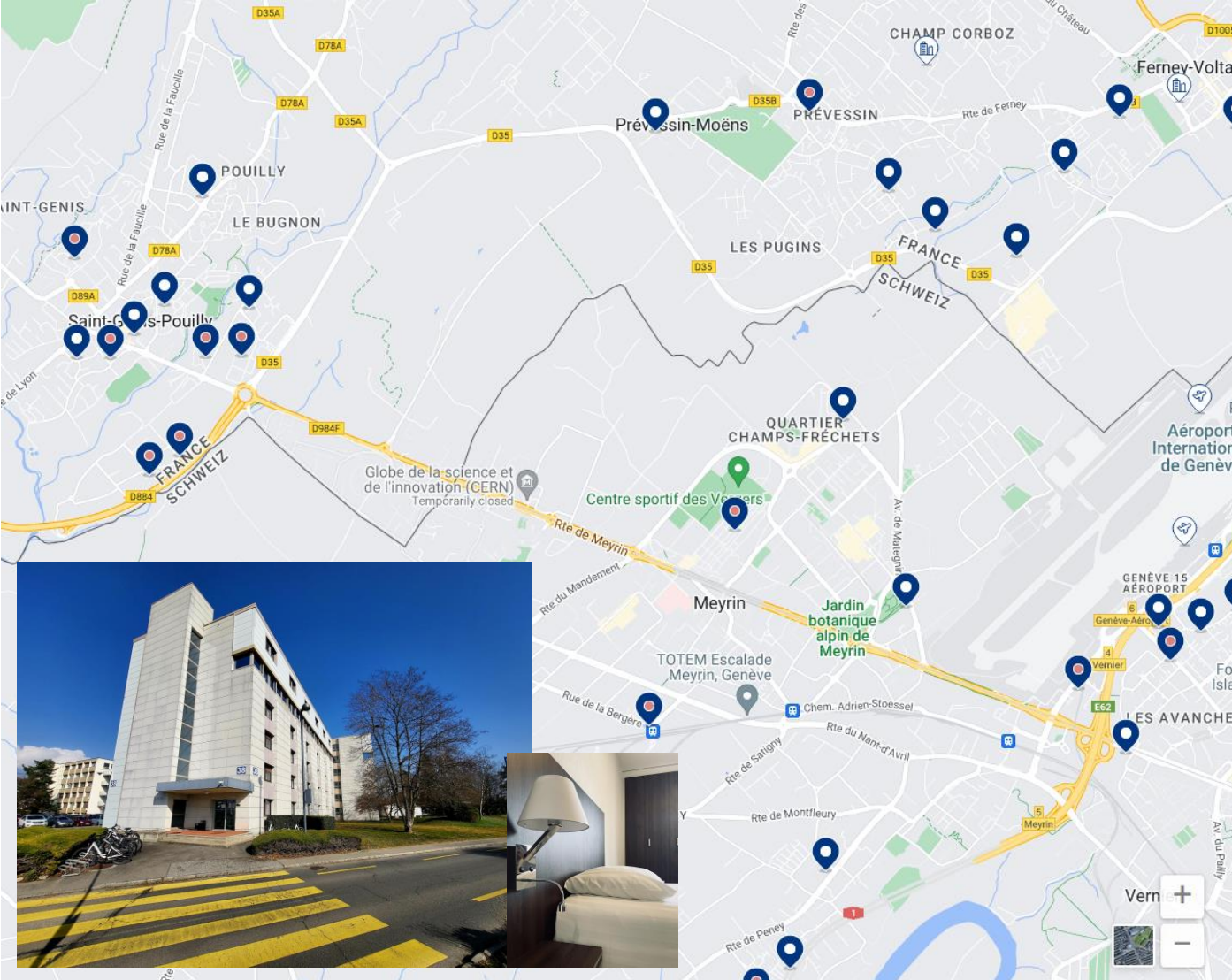


Location

- Provided infrastructure within one of the largest laboratories in the world

Accommodation

- CERN hotel provides 450 rooms on three separate buildings + Saint-Genis hostel (151 rooms; bus to/from both CERN sites)
- Prices vary between 26 EUR/27 CHF to 64 CHF including shared rooms
- Around CERN several other hotels are available with prices starting from 60 CHF





Meals

- Two large restaurants at CERN main side + several cafeterias (R1 is open 7-22; R2: 7-17)
- A selection of five different daily dishes (fish, meat, pasta, vegan meal and pizzas)
 - Price range: 9-25 CHF
