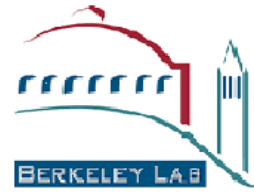

# Container Labeling

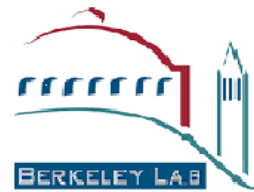


**“All Members of the Workforce involved in the movement of hazardous materials, including radioactive materials, have a unique and critical role in ensuring packages are properly classified, packaged, labeled, and documented to convey relevant hazards. Failing to do so could result in improper handling and movement, personnel injuries or exposures to hazardous materials, or regulatory violations.”**

## **SNL Reviewed 15 Events from 2021-2024**

- In six (40 percent) of the 15 events, packages had proper labeling, but that labeling was either not adhered to or not understood by individuals handling the package. This resulted in the package being stored improperly—either while awaiting movement or after receipt—in an area that was not appropriate for the hazard.
- In five (33 percent) of the 15 events, proper labeling that would have provided important information about the package’s hazards or prompted required radiological or industrial hygiene surveys was not applied to the package.
- In the remaining four events (27 percent), labeling did not represent the hazards in the package accurately (mislabeled). In two of the four cases, labeling was not removed after prior use of the container and did not align with the new contents. In the other two cases, an incorrect label was applied.

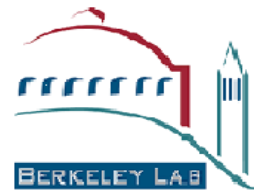
