Ladder Safety



Inspect all ladders before use.

All markings, warnings, and labels (as originally applied) must be legible

Report any defective ladders to your supervisor

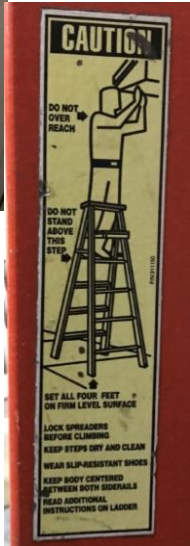
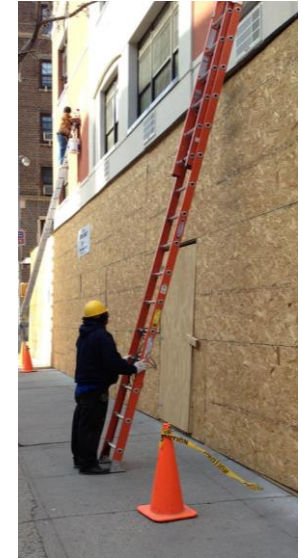
All metal ladders must be legibly marked with signs reading "Caution – Do Not Use Near Electrical Equipment."

Fall Protection ?

Ladders must be stored to prevent weathering, blistering, or cracking

Wooden ladders must not be painted.

Face ladders when ascending or descending



Ladder Safety

Do Not

Use Painters' stepladders longer than 3.7 m (12 ft)

Place a ladder in front of a doorway

Place ladders on boxes or unstable bases to obtain additional height

Climb higher than the second step from the top of a ladder

Use a ladder as a scaffold

Use damaged ladders

Use ladder above the load rating



Ladder Safety (< 30 inches)



Inspect

Know the Capacity

Ensure slip-resistant devices are in place

Positioned firmly on the floor
