

If you’re interested in performing, please sign up by **Thursday, March 26th at 12 noon.**

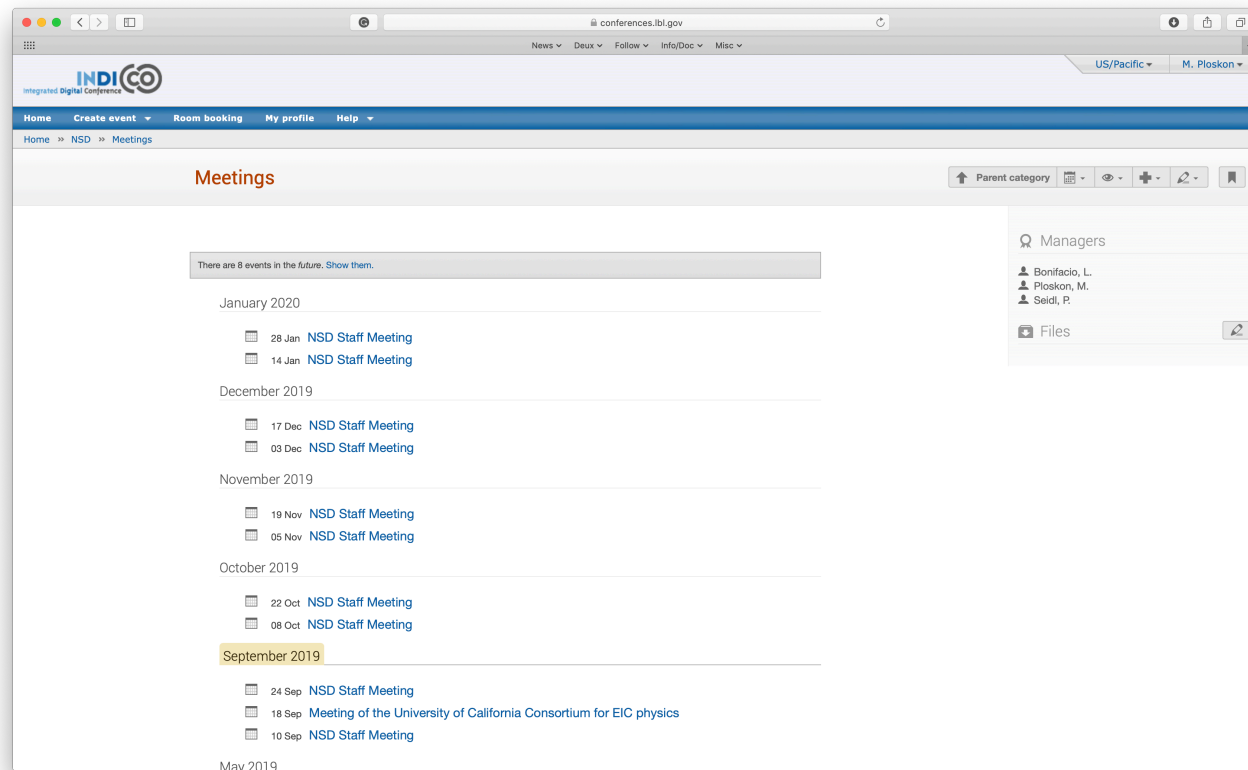
