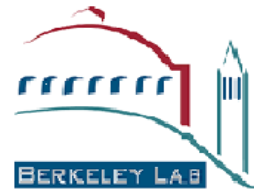

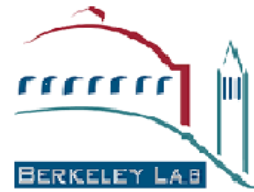

Stop Work



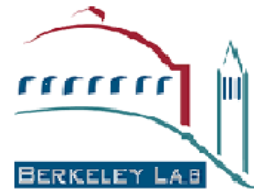
Stop Work

- All Berkeley Lab employees, affiliates, and contractors are responsible for stopping work activities considered to be an imminent danger.
 - Imminent Danger - any condition or practice that could reasonably be expected to cause death or serious injury, or environmental harm

Pause Work

- If conditions change during authorized work activities, and the change may compromise safety or exceed authorized limits, then the work activity must be placed in a safe condition and the work paused.

Cryo Safety



Authorized by a WPC activity, proper PPE (inspected before use), and training, but you need to make sure your WPC activity has all of the required hazards listed.

- **Handling inert, unpressurized cryogenic liquids**
- **Storing cryogenic liquids in commercially available Dewars within enclosed work areas**
- **Filling Dewars or handling streams of cryogenic liquids from a pressurized source**
- **Transporting cryogenic liquids by foot or by vehicle (including elevator)**
