## Five Core Functions of ISM

- Define your work
- Identify the hazards
- Develop Controls
- Complete work within the defined scope and controls
- Feedback and Continuous Improvement



# Implementing ISM



## Work Planning and Control (WPC)

- Work Scope
- Hazards Selected
- Controls Established
- Periodic reviews / renewals
- DOES NOT cover completing the work
  - Everyone (DD, PL, AL, Workers) has some responsibility

# Going Forward



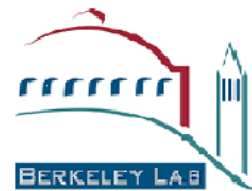
## All NSD Activities Should Be Reviewed

  - Verify work scope and locations are up-to-date
  - Correct Hazards are selected
