Even has these changes are made, we need to make sure all hazardous materials are entered and maintained in the current CMS

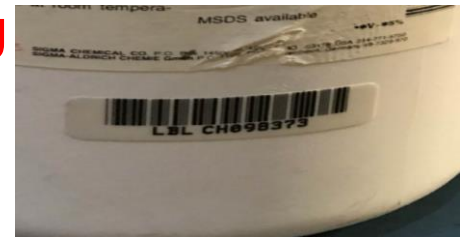
- All consumer adhesives and sealants must be inventoried.
- All gas cylinders shall be inventoried.

Chemical Management



Chemical Owners:

- Must ensure that all hazardous chemicals/materials for which he or she is responsible are entered into the CMS as soon as possible and that all chemicals are removed from or disposed of in the inventory when the materials have been used up, disposed of, or taken off site.
- Accountable for the safe storage of hazardous chemicals
- Verify only trained and authorized personnel handle hazardous chemicals / materials
 - EHS 0348 Chemical Hygiene and Safety
 - EHS 0353-Chemical Hygiene and Safety Refresher Training
 - **EHS 0346 Chemical Management System Training**



Chemical Users:

- Must notify the chemical owner, as soon as possible, when bar coded materials have been used up, disposed of, or moved to a new location.
