

Things That are Happening Now

- Working Towards New Inventory System (June 2022)
- RFID Tags on all Containers (In Process Working on High Hazard)
- Extent of Condition required by all divisions for secondary containers of High Hazard chemicals (Acute Toxicity, Pyrophoric, Time Sensitive, Water Reactive, HF, Explosives)

Even has this is happening, we need to make sure all hazardous materials are entered, maintained, and removed properly in the current CMS

- All consumer adhesives and sealants must be inventoried.
- All gas cylinders shall be inventoried.

RAD Sealed Sources



Requirements found in the WPC activity

- Postings Based on Isotope/Activity
 - Controlled Area Something in the area GERT
 - Radioactive Material Area (RMA) Exceeds Isotope/Activity amount GERT
 - Radiation Area 5 mrem/h @30cm Rad Worker I
- Labeling
 - Required on the source (or container if source too small)
- Dosimetry
 - Whole Body
 - Finger Rings
- Use Log
 - Document use outside of storage location
- During Use
 - Labeled container must remain in the area
 - May use orange "Work in Progress" cone
